<b><u>FACULTY OF ARTS</u></b>  <b>B.A. (HONS.) ENGLISH LANGUAGE</b>	Prospective candidates must possess good grade in at least 2 A-level papers to include both English & Lit-in-Eng OR NCE, OND, HND and Bachelor’s Degree in relevant <b>disciplines</b> plus 5 O/L credits at ONE sitting or 6 O/L credits at TWO sittings including English Language, Literature-in-English, another Arts subject and any other combination of Arts or the Social Sciences are eligible for 4-year Direct Entry admission.	Prospective candidates must possess 5 OR 6 ‘O’ Level credits, in one or two sittings, in English Language & Lit-in-Eng. It is compulsory for the candidates to also possess credits in at least one other Arts Subject PLUS any other subjects from Arts or The Social Sciences.	Lit-in English is compulsory for English Language. Prospective candidates should note that relevant disciplines for Direct Entry admission into the Department include: English Language Linguistics Mass Communication And other disciplines similar to the above stated.
<b>B.A. (HONS.) PHILOSOPHY &amp; PUBLIC AFFAIRS</b>	Candidates with two A-Level papers, NCE, OND, HND and Bachelor’s Degree from any discipline are eligible provided they meet ‘O’ Level requirements of English Language, one Arts subject and any other subjects from Arts, Social Sciences and Science.	Prospective candidates must possess 5 OR 6 ‘O’ Level credits, in one or two sittings, in English Language and another Arts subjects PLUS any other subjects in Arts, Science or The Social Sciences.	Candidates are to note that apart from English Language, another Arts subject is required as O level requirement for both Direct and ‘O’ Level admissions into Philosophy and Public Affairs.

## **GENERAL WAIVERS:**

**1. MATURITY CRITERIA (for 5 Years Programmes ONLY):** Candidates who possess 5 credits at two sittings including English Language may apply on the grounds of maturity/work experience. Such candidates must be at least 26 years old and must provide the following information: Academic qualification, Professional experience, Self-appraisal of Professional Competence, recommendation from competent individuals.

## **2. OPEN ACCESS INITIATIVE**

- Notwithstanding other specific or general requirements, holders of OND, HND and University Diplomas may apply for any Programme of their choice for 4-year programmes provided they possess requisite 'O' Level requirements.
- Bachelor's Degree and Postgraduate Degree holders may apply freely to any Department.

## **3. FAST TRACK MODE**

Candidates with an HND, Bachelor and Higher Degrees can be considered for a FAST TRACK Mode. Fast Track candidates are to note that they will be required to register more courses at each level and thus fulfill their course requirements faster than the normal duration. It is a 3-year programme. In addition, they should note that Fast Track learners pay higher fees than the modes.
